

AAFAME 2011 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- 19 informative training & luncheon programs conducted by industry professionals. This included 1,680 attendees.
- Conducted over 20 committee meetings attended by volunteer members committed to the professionalism and advancement of AAFAME.
- Special recognition of key volunteers who went above and beyond the call of duty.
- Awarded \$2,500 in scholarships as part of our new “AAFAME Education Advancement Scholarship” program for members and their children who are attending college/university programs.
- Awarded 3 scholarships to be used towards the “SMA Designation”.
- Maintained membership level of 445+ setting a new record for total members. This is a 20% increase since 2007.
- Maintained a ratio of 60% engineers and 40% vendors.
- 33% of our building engineer members have earned a BOMI Designation including (RPA, SMA and FMA). And many of our engineers have earned their LEED AP and LEED GA accreditation.
- Conducted CFC & R410A Certification Courses and certified a total of 27 individuals.
- Over 700 attendees at our signature event the 19th Annual Chili Slam held at Krieg Field.
- Held our 9th Annual Vendor EXPO @ the Renaissance Austin Hotel with over 90 booths & 300 attendees.
- Promoted the “Onsite Training” program to deliver training for building personnel at their facilities.
- Our 16th Annual Manager’s Luncheon was attended by over 230 attendees with over 41 property managers in attendance.
- Our Annual Holiday Luncheon was attended by over 275 attendees which is the highest attended luncheon ever!
- Printed a membership directory to be distributed to over 600 commercial real estate professionals and also provided a real time online directory of members including vendor services
- Produced bi-monthly newsletters with association news and articles of interest.
- Sponsored registration at BOMA Extravaganza and provided volunteers to conduct registration.
- Continued relationship building with BOMA and other professional organizations.
